- b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.5.00 Lakhs.
- d) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and **five** teachers for the said course and the staff list is approved by SCERT, Thiruvananthapuram.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Ideal Educational Institute of Teacher Education, Cheplassery, Palakkad District, Pin-679503, Kerala for Elementary (Additional intake) course of two year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 students which includes the existing intake of 50 and an additional intake of 50 subject to fulfillment of the following.
